DNI ISSUES NEW CERTIFICATION AND ACCREDITATION REQUIREMENTS FOR DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE AND INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY AGENCIES

TopSecretProtection.Com will provide Information Systems Security Program Management and Certification and Accreditation Training to ISSM's and ISSO's at DOD and IC Agencies. This will ensure an orderly and smooth transition from DCID 6/3 to the new NIST and CNSS Standards, Policies and Guidelines.

This Director of National Intelligence (DNI) Directive named Intelligence Community Directive (ICD) 503, signed September 15, 2008, rescinds and replaces the Director of Central Intelligence Directive (DCID) 6/3 Policy, Protecting Sensitive Compartmented Information within Information Systems, and the associated DCID 6/3 Manual having the same title. The ICD 503 became effective on September 15, 2008. Any new Information System placed into service after September 15, 2008, will need to be Certified and Accredited (C&A) in accordance with the National Institutes of Standards and Technology (NIST) and the Committee on National Security Systems (CNSS) Standards, Policies and Guidelines.

This change will now enable the Federal Government, Department of Defense (DOD) and Intelligence Community (IC) Agencies to all use a common set of Security Controls for Information Systems, based on NIST Regulations. Supplemental guidance for DOD and IC Agencies will come from the CNSS. This change will better enable all US Government Organizations (DOD/IC) and (Non DOC/IC) to share information and have reciprocity with each other.

The C&A process at most DOD and IC Agencies is performed by the Information Systems Security Manager (ISSM) or the Information Systems Security Officer (ISSO). ISSM'S and ISSO'S within the DOD and IC Agencies who have been managing their Information Systems Security Programs based on the DCID 6/3 Security Requirements and the DCID 6/3 C&A Process, will now have to be trained on a new set of Security Regulations based on the NIST and CNSS Standards, Policies and Guidelines.

To meet the challenges of training these ISSM'S and ISSO'S and to ensure DOD and IC Agencies are in compliance with the ICD 503, TopSecretProtection.Com has created a specialized Information Systems Security Program Management (ISSPM) Training Course.
